Year 12 Trip to Nottingham Trent University - Wednesday 22 November 2017

The school is holding a Collapsed Day on Wednesday 22 November. Instead of normal lessons, we are offering Year 12 students the opportunity to go on a trip to visit Nottingham Trent University.

We are very keen to see all of the Year Group join this trip. It is a great opportunity for those going to find out a little bit more about University life, what to expect, and so on.

The trip is designed to introduce students to University life and study and is suitable for all students interested in going to any University, not just NTU. For those who are not certain about going to University, the trip is undoubtedly a useful way to help make a decision, and we would urge all to go in order to help form a decision about what path to take after September 2018. The programme for the visit is designed by the University and includes various elements including a campus tour and a student life workshop. There is no dress code but students must ensure that they are suitably dressed, as they are representing the school. It is strongly recommended that students bring a packed lunch with them as there may be long queues at the University cafeteria.

The arrangements are as follows:-

- Depart school: Wednesday 22 November 2017 - 8:45am (prompt)
- Return school: Wednesday 22 November 2017 - 4:00pm (approximately)

The College is able to meet some of the cost of this trip and we are asking for contributions of £7.00 to help towards the cost of the transport.

There are limited places available due to the size of the coach and these will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If there isn't sufficient support for this trip it may have to be cancelled. Students not going on the trip will be expected to come into school as normal on this day and will be involved in a programme of activities with Year 13 students.
